ABOUT US:

LOT 2540 Inc. is a 501(c)(3) faith based, human services nonprofit that operates an architectural salvage- recycling store and a mission in Mayodan, North Carolina. Proceeds from the salvage store are used to fund mission programs that serve disadvantaged individuals and families in the greater western Rockingham County area of the Piedmont Triad.

MISSION STATEMENT:

Promote spiritual, emotional and physical restoration for families and individuals of our community.

WHAT WE DO:

We are a living, thriving community that helps people in need move from crisis to stability. Our helping hand is not a hand-out but a help-up. Our goal is to form relationships with our clients and through those connections to see our clients achieve self-sufficiency.

SUMMARY OF PROGRAMS:

- **The Well** – hot meals are served daily to the hungry
- **Monthly Food Pantry** – high quality food boxes are prepared and given away to families and individuals on a monthly basis
- **Lots of Treasures Thrift Shoppe** – gently used items are sold at a deep discount or provided free of charge to those in need
- **Elevate** – Non denominational uplifting worship/prayer services provided two times per week
- **Learn to Earn** – regularly scheduled life skills training sessions for clients who receive vouchers used to purchase items in the Thrift Shoppe.
- **Future programming:** Small business incubator, Life Skills Teaching Kitchen & Learning Lab

The Well Café:

Projected to serve close to 8,500 hot meals this year

LOT Food Bank:

Projected to serve 1,200 boxes of food in 2015, providing a family of 4 food for one week.

Learn 2 Earn/Elevate:

- Average class size: 15
- Retention rate: 83% of students continue to attend classes beyond initial incentives
- 37 students enrolled in classes in 3rd quarter of 2015
- Classes include Christian Discipleship, Basic Skill, Health & Nutrition and Healthy Lifestyles.
